### ADEPTICON POKER TOURNAMENT RULES

The format of the AdeptiCon Poker tournament will be No Limit Texas Hold 'Em. A basic understanding of Poker Tournaments and the rules of No Limit Texas Hold 'Em is assumed.

### POINTS WORTH NOTING

- Players will start with \$1000 in Tournament Chips.
- Rounds will be 12 minutes in duration.
- The following Blind Structure will be used:

- The top 10% of players in the tournament will be eligible for Convention Swag.
- Tables will be set for 9 players max.
- Players will be assigned a seat and a table to begin the tournament.
- Seat 1 at each table will start with the Dealer Button.
- A Dealer Button will be in use and designate the Dealer. The Small Blind will post one to the left of the dealer button and the Big Blind will post two to the left of the dealer button.
- The player designated as the Dealer for a particular hand will deal cards to all players seated at the table starting with the Small Blind first until all players have been dealt two cards.
- The player who dealt the previous hand will be responsible for shuffling the second deck of cards at the table and getting it ready for the next hand.
- When the current hand is over, the player shuffling the cards will hand the deck to the current dealer to cut the cards. The current dealer will then pass the cut cards and the Dealer Button to the Small Blind who will then become the new Dealer.
- When a player is knocked out of the tournament, it is their responsibility to let the Tournament Director know that they are out of the tournament.
- The tournament director will then evaluate if a table move is required to balance tables. If required, the Tournament Director will move the short-stack player from another table behind the button at the current table.
- In the event that a player in the small blind is knocked out of the tournament, a "dead" button will be used and the blinds will post as normal. The dealer who dealt the previous hand will deal again.
