EUROPEAN TEAM CHAMPIONSHIPS QUALIFICATION

The European Team Championships is an annual event in which eight player teams represent their countries to compete for the title of best Warhammer 40K Nation. Only one team represents each country and the competition is stiff as each team fights to win glory for their homeland. In 2009, 16 countries participated. In 2010, for the first time, an American team will journey to Europe to represent our great nation. This is the first year any country outside of Europe will send a team. Yet, in addition to the USA, teams from Australia and Canada have also committed to the event. The 2010 ETC will be the first world competition of Warhammer 40K, and our countries' team is committed to proving that the USA is the best Warhammer 40K nation on the planet!

The 2010 ETC will be held August 7-8th, in Muenster Germany. Each team consists of eight players, and already the best Warhammer 40K players in our country are being gathered to answer the call. Six invitations for a place on the team have been offered and accepted.

The two remaining positions on the American Team will be awarded to the players who have the highest combined battle points in the AdeptiCon 2010 Warhammer 40K Gladiator and Championships Events.

Do you think you have what it takes to represent all Warhammer 40K players in America? Then prove it at AdeptiCon 2010 and claim your place alongside the greatest players in the country!

BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE ETC RULES

1. Each player brings a 1750 pt. army following the standard force organization chart.
2. Each player on a team must play an army from a different codex (i.e. each country can only have one Chaos Space Marine army).
3. The tournament consists of six matches. In each match, there are eight games and the combined results determine which team wins the match.
4. Player matchups are decided by the team Captains immediately prior to the start of a match. The Captains alternate choosing table assignments (terrain layout) and player matchups.
5. Each round, the Captain chooses a "Team Champion" who must play the opposing champion.
6. Teams receive 2 points for winning a match, 1 point for a draw, and 0 points for losing a match.
7. The team with the most points at the conclusion of the tournament is the victor.

ETC TEAM QUALIFICATION RULES AT ADEPTICON 2010

Only players who "opt in" during registration will be considered for a place on the American team. Please only sign up for this competition if you are prepared to devote the time and resources necessary to travel to Muenster Germany on August 7-8th 2010. Keep in mind that if you are given an invitation, you will have four months to make travel preparations.

To sign up for this competition, select the appropriate check box when registering for the AdeptiCon 2010 Warhammer 40K Championship tournament.

Of those who sign up, the top two players who have the highest combined battle point scores from the AdeptiCon Gladiator and AdeptiCon Warhammer 40k Championship will be given invitations to the American team. Those who place 3rd, 4th, 5th, and 6th in this manner will be offered invitations as alternates. If for any reason a confirmed team member has to drop out, alternates will be offered a spot on the team, starting with the 3rd place finisher.
