comic books as well. We host open gaming, tournaments, and leagues with 25+ gaming tables in our 13,000+ sq. ft. space.

## Where are you located and how long have you been in business?

The Toledo Game Room is Located at 3001 W. Sylvania, Toledo, OH, 43613. I have been in business for over 28 years.

## What makes your presence at AdeptiCon unique?

The Toledo Game Room has a unique offering that many of our customers find beneficial; we buy your unwanted miniatures and we find a good home for them.
