### INTRODUCTION

Take to the skies for AdeptiCon's first event with the new Aeronautica Imperialis rules! Play fun games and show off your squadrons as you fly to victory over your foes! If playing games against like-minded, enthusiastic players with fully painted armies is something you aspire towards, or have always dreamed of, then scramble squadron of 250 pts and get in the fight!

#### **BASIC RULES**

- Scenarios: Rynn's World Air War Scenarios
- Number of Games: Four (4)
- Board Size: 18 x 19 Hexes
- Squadron Size: 250-ppoints (your force each round will be chosen from this squadron)
- Follow the Squadron List rules, with the exception that you can't take any named Imperial aces or named Ork aces and only one plane can take the Imperial Ace or Ork Fly Boss upgrade.
- The event will be using the Campaign Play rules found in Rynn's world air war campaign book, including the Experienced Aces Section. However, a pilot will become an Imperial Ace / Ork Fly Boss (or gain a second reroll, in the case of an aircraft that has purchased the Imperial Ace or Ork Fly Boss Upgrade) after participating in and surviving 3 games.
- You must bring two typed copies of your Squadron roster. One you will turn in at registration, the other is to be given to your opponents before each game.
- All players are expected to abide by the <u>AdeptiCon Conduct Policy</u>.
- The models used in your army must comply with the <u>AdeptiCon Model Policy</u> (all models MUST be WYSIWYG and 3-colors). Exceptions made for additional weapons and upgrades.
- AdeptiCon Tournament Judges' and Officers' rulings are final and arguments or poor conduct by players will not be tolerated. AdeptiCon reserves the right to remove players from the event or AdeptiCon itself with no refunds allowed.

### TOOLS OF WAR

- The event is planning on providing the Rynn's World area of engagement for all tables. Due to limited availability of the Rynn's World Area of Engagement product, and in case we cannot enough of the boards, we ask everyone who has the Rynn's World Area of Engagement to bring it to the event if they are willing.
- The players are expected to bring everything else they need to play a game of Aeronautica Imperialis including their squadron, dice, the appropriate half of the Aeronautica Imperialis Imperial and Ork Ground Assets, all relevant rules publications and at least two copies of their squadron roster.

### **MISSI⊕NS/GAMES**

- The games will be played using the scenarios from Rynn's world air war campaign book (page 50-59).
- The points cost for these missions will be on the Mission Briefing Sheets given out at registration.
- You will be given a Flight Log when you register for the event. This will be your record for keeping track of your pilots and their experience as well as who you played against and your achievements.
- After the first round, Attacker and Defender will be determined based on the outcome of your previous round.
- During each round, you will be given a Mission Status Card. At the end of each game, record your achievements in your Flight Log and hand in the completed Mission Status Card to a staff member. The Mission Status Card will record how may aircraft you shot down, which pilot shot them down, if you won or lost the mission and how many of your planes got shot down, and if any of your pilots earned ace status or abilities.
