## STAR WARS: LEGION MAXIMUM FIREPOWER

The AdeptiCon Maximum Firepower Qualifier is the absolute last chance for players to earn an invitation to the vaunted High Command Invitational at AdeptiCon on Saturday, March 30th. This preliminary event will qualify the top eight finishers at a minimum, but we may qualify more depending on available slots for the Invitational. Play like the fate of the galaxy is at stake!

Your epic Legion journey may not end there as the top eight players from the High Command Invitational will advance to the invite-only and highly prestigious Star Wars: Legion World Championships later this year!

### BASIC RULES

This event will utilize the Star Wars: Legion Rules and the Organized Play documents found on the [Fantasy Flight Games Star Wars Legion Support page](#) and [Official Legion Rules Thread](#).

- Armies must consist of **800 points** or less.
- Players will play four Swiss-paired rounds. Each round will be 2.5 hours consisting of 15 minutes of prep, 120 minutes of game time, and 15 minutes of wrap-up following time being called, with a hard-dice down call resulting in immediate scoring at that time.
- Players should bring two barricades as part of their roster. Players will place 0-2 barricades before the blue player is chosen. Barricades must be placed at least range 2 away from any other core set barricade.
- Registered players will be asked to create an account on Table Top TO ([TTO](#)). Once your account has been created, please email the TO at [legion@adepticon.org](mailto:legion@adepticon.org) so your profile can be linked with our event.
- At a minimum the top 8 will qualify for the High Command Invitational. Additional qualifiers will be awarded to fill all High Command slots.
- All players are expected to abide by the [AdeptiCon Conduct Policy](#).
- The models used in your army must comply with the [AdeptiCon Model Policy](#) (all models **MUST** meet the standard 3-colors paint rule).
- AdeptiCon Tournament Judges' and Officers' rulings are final and arguments or poor conduct by players will not be tolerated. AdeptiCon reserves the right to remove players from the event or AdeptiCon itself with no refunds allowed.
- Results for AdeptiCon Star Wars Legion weekend will be tracked and determine either an Imperial or Rebel overall victory. These results will have implications for Star Wars: Legion events at AdeptiCon 2020.

### LIST REQUIREMENTS

- Players must submit their army composition, including all associated Battle Cards and your Command Hand via Table Top TO before midnight EST on March 19th. Players who fail to complete this task on time will start the event with a foul. Players who do not submit their list before the event will be dropped from the tournament. ([Table Top TO Event](#))
- Additionally each player should provide each opponent with a list for review during the 15 minute prep. Players should bring 4 printed copies of their list.
- Players must use the same list for the duration of the tournament, including all battle cards and command hand cards.
- Players are responsible for bringing all of the game components they need to play a game of STAR WARS: Legion. This includes their army, order tokens for each unit, command hand, sufficient dice for attack and defense rolls, movement tools, and a range ruler. In addition, players must bring 12 unique objective, deployment, and condition battle cards, four of each type.
